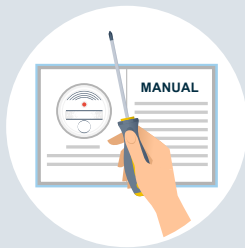




LEARNING ABOUT PORTABLE GENERATOR SAFETY

Carbon monoxide alarms.

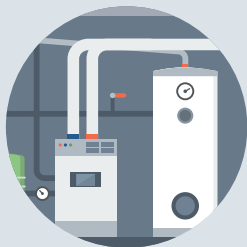
Since carbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odorless, tasteless gas, it is important to install CO alarms in your living spaces to help keep you safe.



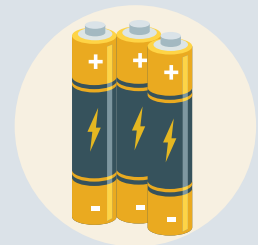
Follow installation instructions carefully.



Change the batteries regularly.



Install CO alarms in all living spaces, including the basement.



Have backup batteries on hand, even for plug-in alarms.



Avoid installing alarms near vents or drapes and furniture.



Use the test button to make sure unit is operating properly.

CO alarms protect you from the dangers of carbon monoxide poisoning.
